Daria is also organising some activities for the students to take part in. Lunch orders will still be available on this day.



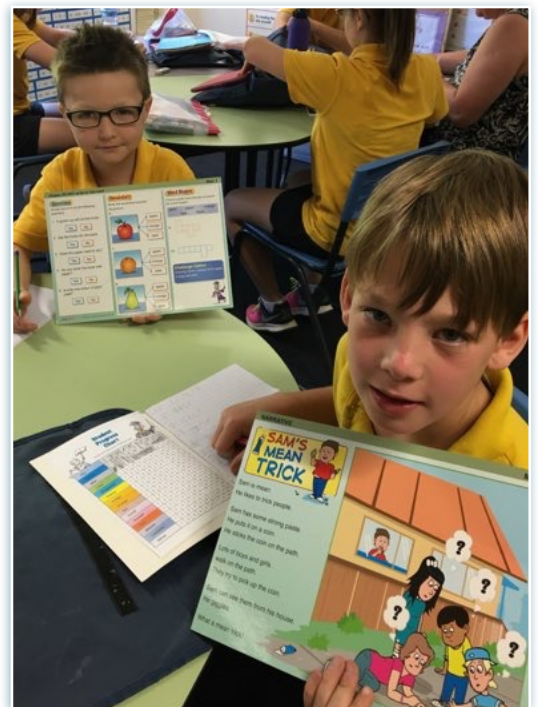
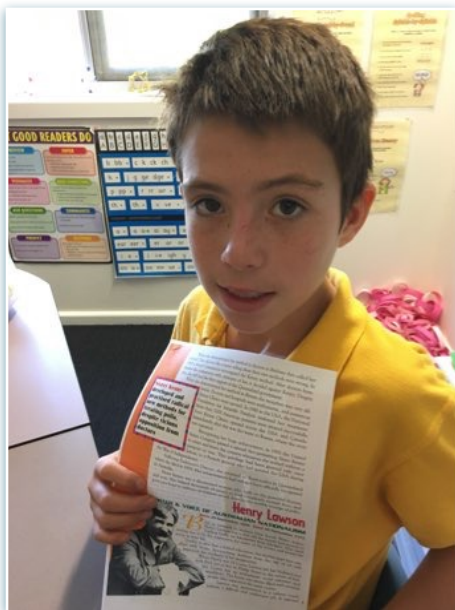
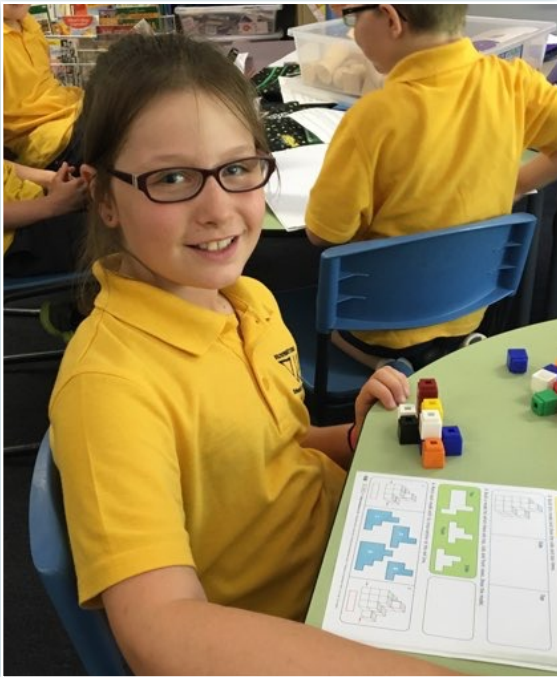
## No News
